FAC started as an informal network in 2013. In 2023, it became a not-for-profit company & Arts Council England '<u>IPSO</u>' to provide sector support for arts centres and their leaders.

FAC has also successfully delivered national co-created artistic programmes (like <u>Here and Now and People's Plan for Nature</u>) & international collaborations (like <u>Global-Vision</u>).
